Feudo Santa Tresa "Rina Lanca" Grillo Viognier	\$25
Tropical fruit and vanilla. Round and lush.	
Torroxal Albarino 2004 ( <i>Rias Baixas</i> )	\$23
Not your typical Albarino. Dark and soft with a touch of oak.	
Caposaldo Pinot Grigio 2007 ( <i>Veneto</i> )	\$25
A great Pinot Grigio. Clean, crisp, and fresh.	
San Felice Vermentino 2007 ( <i>IGT</i> )	\$24
Bright fruit with a Sauvignon Blanc punch on the end.	
Villa Rosa Gavi 2007 ( <i>Gavi</i> )	\$25
A great alternative to Pinot Grigio. Bright and fresh, with a scent of lemon.	
Red Mud Unoaked Chardonnay 2005 ( <i>South Australia</i> )	\$24
Crisp and fresh.	
Lamoreaux Landing Chardonnay 2006 ( <i>Finger Lakes</i> )	\$25
This will make you believe that New York can make great wines.	
Golan Heights Winery "Yarden" Chardonnay 2001	\$26
Yes they grow grapes in Israel...a great Chardonnay.	
Heron Hill "Ingle Vineyard" Riesling 2005	\$28
A dry Riesling from the private estate of the owner.

### Rose

Penguin Bay Rose of Chambourcin 2006 ( <i>Finger Lakes</i> )	\$19
Nice light rose with slight sweetness to it.	
Torres "De Casta" Rose 2004 ( <i>Catalunya, Spain</i> )	\$21
Crisp but with big fruit.	

### Reds

Ninth Island Pinot Noir 2005 ( <i>Tasmania</i> )	\$28
A nice light Pinot with a fragrant nose.	
High Vines Pinot Noir 2005 ( <i>Vin De Pays D'OC</i> )	\$24
Bright cherries and violets.	
Red Mud Shiraz 2003 ( <i>South Australia</i> )	\$24
A classic Shiraz from Australia. Fruit driven, spicy and smooth.	
Finca el Origen Reserva Malbec 2007 ( <i>Mendoza</i> )	\$24
Fun in a bottle. Lots of fruit and a little spice. Very nice!!!	
Benziger Syrah 2005 ( <i>North Coast</i> )	\$27
Think of jam and spice.	
Truchard Syrah 2001 ( <i>Carneros</i> )	\$29
Taste what eight years of aging does to a great wine. Soft and velvety smooth.	
Jade Mountain Mourvedre 2003 ( <i>Contra Costa</i> )	\$27
Medium-bodied with fruit and spice.	
Torremoron Tempranillo 2005 ( <i>Ribera del Duero</i> )	\$24
Lush cherries and a elegant finish. Spain rocks!	
Jacob's Creek Reserve Merlot 2004 ( <i>South Australia</i> )	\$24
Lush and round.	
Louis Martini Cabernet Sauvignon 2006 ( <i>Sonoma</i> )	\$28
Not too often do you come across a cab this good at this price. 90 pts.!	
Golan Heights Winery "Yarden" Cabernet Sauvignon 2001 ( <i>Galilee, Israel</i> )	\$28
This is a well-made wine! Firm tannins and lush black fruit prevail, with nice oak balance on the finish.	
Pellegrini Vineyards Cabernet Sauvignon 2002	\$29
A nice soft cab with great balance.	
Flora Springs Sangiovese 2006 ( <i>Napa</i> )	\$29
Ripe fruit and bright acid. Makes you think of cranberries.	
Rodney Strong Merlot 2004 ( <i>Sonoma</i> )	\$28
A classic from a great producer.	
St. Francis Sonoma Red 2004 ( <i>Sonoma</i> )	\$25
This red blend is loaded with fruit and spice.	
Ruffino Aziano Chianti Classico 2006	\$23
